Send us a photograph (or photograph of your drawing, painting or mural, sculpture or other artistic object) with sufficient resolution to be printed in color in A3 format, preferably in vertical orientation, to the address edlg@iessanclemente.net until April the 26th, 2015.

Accompany your submission with a text, mentioning the name of the work and/or an explanation, reflection, etc. You can also send a link to a short video related to your work.

Do not forget to sign your picture (© Name Surname, country, year of completion) in a discreet but visible place.

All submissions will be printed and exhibited to celebrate the Week of Arts Education in May 2015 in the city of Santiago de Compostela (Galicia, Spain). Artists will receive a certificate of participation. We will also publish a catalog of the exhibition with ISBN, in Galician.

In the main body of their submission email, artists must include:

- 1. Details of the work: title of the work, characteristics (date, actual size, technique).
- 2. Brief explanatory text, poem or reflection to accompany the image.
- 3. Personal details of the author: full name, workplace, city, country, email address, postal address and link to the profile in arteweb.ning.com
- 4. Authorization for the work to be printed, to be included in the catalog, web space, virtual and real exposure within the context of the Project Exhibitions Tangled in the NET coordinated by Angeles Saura (UAM: PR-007)
- 5. Authorization for the texts of points 1 and 2 to be translated and published in Galician language.
